Background and the Need

Life after the age of 60 is often referred to as the "Golden Period," a time when senior citizens aspire to live with dignity, safety, and care. However, the changing social and family structures in India have led to significant challenges for the elderly population.



Demographic Trends:

India's elderly population is expected to reach 347 million by 2050, reflecting a significant demographic shift. The increase in longevity, coupled with a decline in fertility rates, has resulted in a growing proportion of older individuals in the population. The main challenges faced by the elderly are social isolation and neglect. The majority elderly individuals experience feelings of loneliness, powerlessness, and depression. Health issues and lack of comprehensive social safety increases their vulnerability. Community living for the senior citizens found to be the best solution which will greatly reduce the problem of their dependency and isolation. As a result "Aastha Foundation Aurangabad" NGO was established and registered under societies and trust act in 2008.

One of the trustees, Shri Sunil Agrawal in the memory of his father, gifted 3 acre land to Aastha Foundation. Out of planned 25000 sq.ft, 14700 sq.ft construction is completed in first phase and full fledged functioning started from 22/01/2023. The salient features of this project are:

PROJECTS:

1. Basant Prabha Visawa – A Dream Project.

Objective:

To ensure that Sr. Citizens are given Respect, Safety & Security, Comfort, Love and Dignity.

To rehabilitate their individuality and give back their identity & dignity as productive seniors.



Salient Features of the Project:

Three acre charming natural environment, Beautiful airy, spacious rooms with attached wash room. All facilities necessary for old age people are taken care off. All amenities like garden, walking track, library, meditation hall, entertainment zone, counselling available. Health Care, Physical and Emotional assistance,

A team of trained geriatric caregivers round the clock to take care of all residents including dementia patients. Doctors visit two times a week, ambulance service in case of emergency available. Facility of Rehabilitation of operated patients for physiotherapy is provided.

2. Certificate Course in Geriatric Care



Objective

The course is conducted in association Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Vaidyakiya Pratisthan as knowledge partner & Savitribai Phule Mahila Ekatm Samaj Mandal as Implementation Partner and Aastha Foundation Aurangabad as organizing partner

Duration: 2 months

Conducted at Dr. Hedgewar Rugnalaya by renowned and experience doctors. Visits to other old age home are arranged for practical training and study. On completion, The Certificates will be issued to successful students.

No fees is charged to the students

Till date 12 branches conducted and a team of 150 trained caregivers are available for providing services.

Focus Area:

Practical Training, Effective Communication, Understanding the Emotions, Service Skills

3. Community Physiotherapy Centre and Out Patient Checking

Considering the importance of Physiotherapy and Physical Exercise to the residents, caregivers & all we have tie up with MGM School of physiotherapy. On every Thursday 11.00 to 13.00, A Team of Physiotherapy School of MGM University visits and engages residents in Physical exercises and physical interesting games giving entertainment.

Other Doctors also visit for OPD.

Focus Area

Physical Check-up of Residents. Free OPD for Residents as well as to local people residing in nearby area.

4. Dementia Awareness Projects

The trust is taking rigorous efforts in the area of dementia which is common in old age now a days.

Activities include:

Every year in the month of September Creating Awareness regarding its symptoms through brochures, Rally with slogans followed by Lectures by the renowned experts. Diagnosis, Care and Precautions camps are arranged every year in the month of September Conducting Regular Training Programs for the care givers of dementia patient including family care givers.



Focus Area:

Increase Memory, Medical Advice, Enlightenment, Entertainment, Physical Care.

5. Day Care Centre for Dementia Patients

A unique activity started in 2018, run by Trained Volunteers and Trained Caregivers to give respite to family caregivers and Positive and Change environment to dementia patients. Each person is attended by one caregiver appointed by the trust.

6. Free Pneumonia Vaccination Camps



Every year during 1st week of October (**Joy of Giving week**) free Vaccination Camps are arranged in neglected areas with an objective to make slum areas and rural areas free from Pneumonia. Till date about 500plus below poverty line persons are vaccinated.
