Starts with the Establishment of Geriatric Nursing Home

At Aastha Foundation, our journey toward creating a joyful and dignified old age continues to evolve with the changing needs of our elders and the society around them. As we look ahead, we envision not just sustaining our current efforts but expanding into new areas that can bring a lasting impact.

OUR VISION / PERSPECTIVE

We believe that ageing should not be associated with pain or dependence, but with comfort, dignity, purpose and support. To achieve this, we are setting our sights on three key pillars:

FIVE-YEAR ROADMAP (2025–2030)

- To establish a comprehensive Physiotherapy Centre at Aastha Foundation with advanced equipment and trained staff.
- To expand the scope of our Certificate Course in Geriatric Care with new modules and field internships.
- To train caregivers and community volunteers to deliver in-home physiotherapy and basic elder support

Year 2 – 3: Launching a Training Centre for Elder Care

- Set up a dedicated Elder Care Training Centre, affiliated with recognized bodies, offering short and long-term courses in:-
- Geriatric care
- Palliative care
- Dementia support
- Collaborate with hospitals, NGOs and institutions to offer practical training and placements.

Year 3 – 5: Starting Educational Institutions

- Begin groundwork to establish a Physiotherapy College focused on geriatric rehabilitation and community health.
- Obtain necessary accreditations and permissions.
- Identify land and infrastructure requirements.
- Simultaneously initiate planning for a Nursing College, with a special wing for elder care nursing.
- Create curriculum that blends compassion with clinical expertise.
- Partner with hospitals and elder care facilities for hands-on experience.

OUR LONG-TERM GOAL

To develop Aastha Foundation into a Centre of Excellence for Joyful Aging - combining residential home and with the continued support of our trustees, donors, well-wishers, and community partners - we are confident of making it a reality.

2. CERTIFICATE COURSE IN GERIATRIC CARE

SALIENT FEATURES OF THE PROJECT

Started "Certificate Course in Geriatric Care" since 2015. Aastha Foundation Aurangabad is organising this course in association with Savitribai Phule Mahila Ekatm Samaj Mandal using syllabus designed by TISS.



The course is Conducted at Dr. Hedgewar Rugnalaya by renowned and experienced doctors. Visits to other old age home are arranged for practical training and study. To date 13 batches have been conducted and team of 160 trained caregivers are available for service.

OBJECTIVE

To create a team of trained caregivers for old age people living in the city and also for Aastha Foundation Aurangabad recognizing the need of trained caregivers.




